CASE STUDY | ManTech

A "Handy" Tale of ATA Carnet Success

We all know the pains of import taxes, but what happens when you need to move goods between countries that are not for sale?

ManTech Automation Ltd found themselves in that exact position earlier this year when they were contracted to install some electrical components in a large manufacturing hub in Belgium.

Like any good tradesperson, they needed their tools to get the job done, but were unsure of how to get them through customs without getting stung with import tax (in both directions!)

That's where we stepped in to help. Connor worked with

them to ensure they had all the documentation they needed, including an ATA Carnet.



The ATA Carnet is a special document that can be used for things that are moving in or out of a country, but not being sold. Think filming props and cameras for the movie industry, exhibition equipment, or tools... It prevents the items from being seized at customs and means you don't have to pay duties and taxes on them.

With all the paperwork in order, ManTech was able to take their essential tools (a whole 6 boxes of them!) to Belgium to complete the project, without any stress, hassle or duties due.





I've been in freight for over 30 years and I've never seen this happen before.


We move a lot of cargo, as you can imagine. And when you scale things to this kind of level, sometimes crazy stuff happens that you'd never expect.

Now, as you know, at Millennium Cargo, we make it our mission to make sure your goods get to where they need to go. We're the pros when it comes to planning freight routes, advising on packaging, rules and regulations and customs charges. All the things that you need to get right if you want smooth sailing for your cargo. That said, when you're dealing with the oceans, you can't guarantee safe passage. It's very rare but sometimes something happens that means your cargo is lost. Pirate attacks, hurricanes, container fires... you get the gist? That's why we always advise all our customers to get cargo insurance every single time. I mean, just look at the recent Baltimore Bridge incident? The cargo on that ship will likely never make it to its end destination. It's super rare, but lost, stolen or damaged containers do happen.

Do you know what I've never seen happen until now? An empty container... Picture this. You package up your goods, in this case a container full of mattresses, and send them on their merry way across the ocean. Weeks go by and all seems well. The ship is tracked, on time and arrives in the port with your container intact. But when you crack that baby open, what do you find? Nothing. Zip. Zilch. Nada. Just an empty container! The cargo was missing. No signs. No clues. So we put on our Sherlock

Holmes hats and got on the case... A little digging and delving later, we discovered what had happened.

The container and its cargo had made it through to customs where they'd removed the mattresses to examine them. All fairly typical stuff... But instead of putting the cargo back in the container once it had been cleared, they accidentally put it in the wrong warehouse bay – the one for cargo that must be destroyed! Poof! Up in flames. Never to be seen again. Crazy, huh? Bet you never thought something like that could happen

What do you think sets our company apart from others in the industry?

It has been our mantra for so long, but rightly so is our honesty and integrity. We're not a big faceless forwarder, but a personal "one-stop-shop" for everything freight.

Can you share a memorable or rewarding experience you've had while working at Millennium Cargo?

In my first year in freight, I visited Southampton Port and boarded an actual container ship. This really helped me understand firsthand what we do on a day-to-day basis and just how big the industry is. It always amazes me how many people who have been in this industry for a long time have never seen a vessel up close to really understand its size and what we really do.

Outside of work, what are your hobbies or interests?

Very simple, ASTON VILLA FC – my biggest hobby by a country mile, traveling up and down the country and throughout Europe all year-round supporting the team home and away. I also love spending quality time with friends and family and finally I am a huge combat sports fan. I love watching the UFC and being able to go to a live world title fight last year was a fantastic experience.

What motivates you to perform your best at work every day?

As a young and passionate freight forwarder working in our family business, my motivation to perform at my best every day is deeply rooted in the values of integrity and personal service that we uphold. Being part of a family business instills a strong sense of responsibility and pride in me. I understand that our family's reputation is directly tied to the quality of service we provide.

What is a valuable lesson you've learned from your time working in this industry?

Attention to detail is KEY, the simplest things can be the most impactful. Duty and Care is number 1 always when dealing with cargo for all our customers and partners.

If you could give one piece of advice to clients or colleagues in the industry, what would it be?

Nothing is ever a stupid question in this industry. It is better to check and repeat then be complacent and make mistakes. This industry is always evolving but be excited to tackle the challenge rather than shy away from it.

If you could have a superpower, what would it be and why?

If I could have a superpower, it would undoubtedly be the ability to speak every language fluently. To me, the power of language is unparalleled. It goes beyond mere communication; it's a gateway to understanding different cultures, establishing connections, and bridging gaps between people.

What's your favourite travel destination or dream vacation spot?

It is hard to say one because different destinations offer different experiences and different types of vacations. From a relaxing point of view, I just want to be close to the beach and have plenty of sunshine. From a tourist point of view, a big goal of mine is to visit the 7 wonders of the world.
